Call to order by President Mary Bailey at 5:00.

Present were: Mary Bailey, Don T. Caffery, Cherie Laiche, Jane Luke, Jason Watson, Lucy Watson and Julie Champagne. Absent were Karla Vappie and Ken Singleton.

Approval of the agenda as expanded to include election of officers. Motion: Mr. Caffery moved that the agenda be accepted as expanded. Second: Mr. Watson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approval of minutes: Motion: Mrs. Laiche moved that the October 3rd, November 19th Public Hearing and the November 19th called meeting minutes all be approved as presented. Second: Mrs. Watson seconded the motion. Motion carried.
