Centerville hours/survey/possibilities: The possibility of totally changing and reducing Centerville's hours was discussed including swapping hours and bringing back some Saturday hours. Also the broad results of the survey were discussed. The survey is ongoing until Thanksgiving. The Board is committed to exploring the process to consider if or when it is feasible to begin the construction of a new facility.
