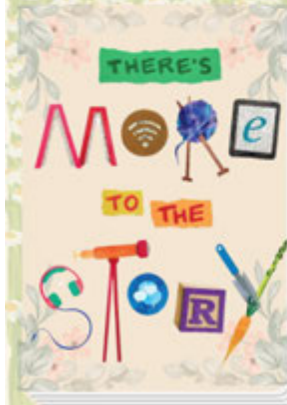
NATIONAL LIBRARY WEEK
