



St. Mary Parish Library is transitioning to a new platform for eBook and eAudiobook lending. The new platform, cloudLibraryTM, will provide an app that is extremely easy for all users and allows the library to manage its content and offer more to you through a partnership with other libraries across Louisiana. On March 13, 2024, the collection within OverDrive will be turned off and those titles will be moved over into cloudLibrary throughout the day. Holds and reading history will not be transferred over. The new cloudLibrary app can be found in app stores, or you can find the link at **www.yourcloudLibrary.com.** Download the app to begin browsing, borrowing, and reading/listening to our collection. Once the app is added to your device, there is a simple, one-time sign-in process of selecting the library and entering the library card number and pin. If you need help downloading the cloudLibrary app or any other help with cloudLibrary, we encourage you to visit your local library branch. Our staff are here to help you with this transition.






