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Bayou Vista Leaks: There is mold and mildew in the Bayou Vista Branch. It is not on state contract, and a declared emergency will last for 45 days. There is currently no idea for shut down or cost. It was decided that they would return to Callais Roofing for assistance.

Mezzanine concerns: The mezzanine concerns revolve around young adults and juveniles leaning too far against the railing. The contractor will be contacted flip the mezzanine fence. The approximate cost for this is \$5,000 - \$12,000.

Security cameras upgrades and installations: There is a concern for installing security cameras for all branches including upgrades to Franklin and Patterson. There is a state contract for upgrades and new cameras; these installations will be located near the money, circulation desks, and manager's office. There will also be a camera near the time clock to prevent time card fraud. Staff will be notified of this development during staff training, and they will be told to refrain from informing patrons of the additional cameras.

Directors Report: The Summer Reading Program was a success including the Boys & Girls S.T.E.A.M. activities. The attendance was approximately the same. On October 9th, there will be the Support Staff Conference in Shreveport, Louisiana. It is \$40.00 - \$60.00 a person, and this will be LA convergence. In regards to comp time, there will be time off at the end of the day for those who attended. The mezzanine incident with the youth will be kept on record.
