In 2004, when the Library Board appointed her to her leadership position, Julie and the Library Board collaborated on expanding our library system. Their collaboration produced the opening of Centerville Library in 2009, and subsequently, Julie led multiple library renovation projects in Franklin, Berwick, and Patterson. During COVID-19, Julie's attention to detail and adherence to CDC guidelines ensured staff continued to provide quality resources and services to our beloved community within safety measures. In 2023, she was the recipient of the Louisiana Library Association's Library Director of the Year award, an award that acknowledges a library director's outstanding contributions. St. Mary Parish Library remains grateful for Julie's contributions to our library system and wishes her a wonderful retirement.

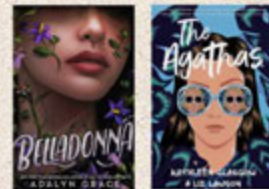
